Position: Program – Video & Photography Assistant

Purpose and Scope :

Camp Kwasind, a ministry of the Canadian Baptists of Ontario & Quebec is a Christian Camp that seeks develop and nurture Christian faith and relationships through effective programs in a safe, exciting, and natural environment. It is our aim to be a living demonstration of God's love which is demonstrated through our care for all of creation, providing quality programming, and the intentional reaching out to those on route to Jesus as we live as a community of faith.

The Video & Photography Assistant is focused on the successful capturing, editing, and producing of quality photos for social media & brochures along with highlight video of each week including Epic Family Getaways, L.I.T. and Teen Week. They will provide support to the Assistant Director - Program as they serve as part of the Program Team. They will report to the Assistant Director - Program. This is a seasonal summer camp position.

Qualifications:

- A mature faith in Jesus Christ and an active part of a local church.
- Commitment to the mission, faith, philosophy, staff code of conduct and core values of CBOQ & Camp Kwasind.
- Have experience of working with children and youth in a creative and fun atmosphere.
- Have creative experience and a portfolio of video and photography work.
- Have superior video production, computer, and technical knowledge.
- Have their own equipment to supplement what camp can provide.
- Possessing a valid driver's license is an asset.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision and work to deadlines.

Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in Camp Staff Training at the beginning of the camping season.
- Film and edit highlight video throughout each weekly camp session to produce a YouTube Video of the camp week for each camper to download once they get home.
- Photography for the brochure and social media key elements of camp.
- Record still photos for inclusion on the weekly Highlight Video and for archival and promotion.
- Produce theme-based videos each week.
- Set up and operate audio for camp worship times.
- Assist with AV needs at worship times, dining hall, movie times etc.
- Compiling and playing audio clips to support various elements of the program and theme including meals.
- Assist program team for campfires and puppetry and other program elements.

- As requested, serve as a Cabin Buddy where you will assist in spiritual conversations, prayers for campers and being a model of Christian living to those campers in that cabin.
- Attend all staff meetings, trainings, and staff bible study/faith practise and weekly chapels
- Other duties as assigned by the Managing Director.
